Planting Your Garden this Fall!

Quick! Which season do you consider the best time to plant and garden? If you said spring, you're not completely wrong...but you'd actually be missing the ideal season to get your perennial flowers and especially "woodies" (shrubs and trees) into the ground.

As summer fades and autumn approaches, now is the time to get new plants in the ground. Trees and shrubs begin dormancy in anticipation of winter making them less likely to die upon transplanting. They'll also have more time to acclimate to soil conditions before further establishing root systems in the spring, making them more likely to flourish the following year.

Consider planting native species in your yard this year. Natives benefit the entire food chain of local wildlife, helping to enhance biodiversity in our local ecosystems. Non-native species – which include most of the plants sold at commercial nurseries and big box stores – often provide severely reduced or even negative benefits to the surrounding ecosystem.

Plant NOVA Natives is a great resource for choosing the best native plants based on your site's conditions (e.g. sun/shade, wet/dry) and so much more. Check out their list of native-only plant nurseries in the area and upcoming plant sales where you can get new plants as well as talk to experts (https://www.plantnovanatives.org/local-native-plant-sales). One of the best native plant events locally is the Northern Alexandria Native Plant Sale, taking place on Saturday, October 2, 2021, 9am-2pm. See the link for more info!

Composting Correction

In the Summer 2021 issue of Limelight, we incorrectly stated that "composting yard waste in Loft Ridge is prohibited." While in fact compost piles are prohibited (and yard waste should never be tossed into the common or forested areas), we wanted to offer the correction that in fact composting is allowed in our HOA. As the HOA Handbook indicates on p. 10: "Composting shall be restricted to an enclosed composting bin in the rear of the house on ground level. Composting piles are not permitted." 
